Overview

This course is an introduction to linguistics, the science of language. We will cover the basics of most major subfields in linguistics: the sciences of word formation (morphology), sound (phonetics and phonology), sentence structure (syntax), meaning (semantics and pragmatics), as well as sociolinguistics, language acquisition, and language change.

20% Reading quizzes
