

# University of Pennsylvania Penn Summer Abroad Cost Sheet for 2024

## TOURS, FRANCE

### **Tuition & Program Fee**

The tuition and program fee are charged to the student's Penn account according to the Summer Sessions billing schedule. Tuition and fees are subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees of the University of Pennsylvania and may change without notice. Tuition and fees below reflect rates for 2023 or estimated rates for 2024. Rates for summer 2024 programs will be available in spring 2024.

<b>PROGRAM FEE</b> Includes administrative costs, accommodations, all breakfasts and dinners, and excursions	\$2,500

### **Additional Expenses**

The following are other expenses to consider which are not included in the program fee. The actual cost will vary depending on the student's spending habits, extent of personal travel and fluctuations in the exchange rate or inflation.

As a reference: Students who attended the program in previous years estimated their basic on-site expenses for the five weeks (excluding the roundtrip ticket) to be between \$500-\$1,000 but a few spent \$1,500 or more depending on the amount of shopping/entertainment and personal travel to other parts of France on the weekends.

<b>PASSPORT &amp; VISA (if needed)</b> A valid passport is required. A visa is not needed for U.S. Citizens. Citizens from other countries should confirm if they need a visa.
<b>HEALTH INSURANCE</b> Make sure you understand how your current health insurance works overseas and if necessary, purchase additional coverage. All participants are covered by Penn's group policy with International SOS for Emergency and Medical Assistance. This primarily provides coverage for emergency evacuations and repatriation, as well as in-country medical and legal referrals.
<b>ROUND-TRIP AIRFARE to Paris, France</b> Estimate \$900-\$1,500 traveling from the East Coast U.S. We recommend purchasing travel insurance for any unexpected trip cancellation or interruption.
<b>LOCAL TRANSPORTATION</b> Estimate \$125 for buses, metro, tram, etc.
<b>COURSE MATERIALS</b> There are no required purchases or bulk packs.
<b>LUNCH</b> Estimate \$15-\$20 per day
<b>PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS</b> In addition to other entertainment or personal travel, consider cellphone costs (equipment, + pay as you go calls); \$150-\$300
